We have had another very busy and successful year at Beeliar Primary School. Our children have worked hard in class to maximise their learning in all of the learning areas including English, mathematics, science and history. External assessments such as the Australian Government's NAPLAN system assessments demonstrate that our students are coping well with the curriculum offered to them.

On the sports field, we have had many successes this year. We finished second in B Division in the interschool Athletics Carnival and a commendable second for the team events. We also placed second overall in the Summer and Winter interschool competitions with a commendable first place in Basketball A and B in the Summer Competition. We competed in touch rugby competitions with the Year 5 girls making the finals. We also competed for the first time in the CCEN interschool cross country event and our children did us proud.

Our Arts program continues to grow under the leadership of three specialist teachers. This year, the children's artistic talents were again proudly displayed in classroom drama performances and a Visual Arts Exhibition at Atwell College. All of the students from Pre-primary to Year 6 performed with distinction for their parents during their normal classroom lessons. The choir performed at Lakeland Senior High School's Evening on the Green, on ANZAC Day, and during special assemblies. Guitar students performed for the Year 4-6 students at their Block Meeting.

We have had a great many successes with our "Stand Tall" and pastoral care programs. We have continued our student mentor program as well as our outstanding Values and Virtues Program, having fun and learning along the way.

This year we have 26 families leaving Beeliar Primary School most which have their youngest child graduating from the school. We have mixed feelings when the children graduate – we celebrate with them their readiness to move on to the next stage of their lives but we will also miss them – just as we will miss you. You have been there for your children, as well as for us, and we thank you so very much for sharing your children's journey with us.

Children are our hope for the future. At Beeliar, we ask our children to work hard, to work independently and to work to set goals in order to achieve their potential. We encourage students to grasp learning opportunities and the challenges put before them to become independent learners. The opportunities offered at this school are really quite superb. With your support and encouragement we will continue to assist the children of BPS to 'Stand Tall' and reach their fullest potential.

It has once again been a great year and the P&C was able to give the school \$18,500 which has given our school the new sports shade tents and flags, reading books and hats for all new students to name just a few.

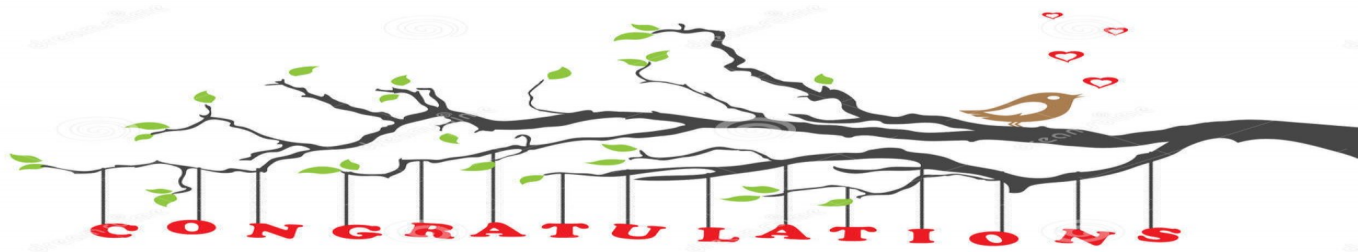
Next year will see us run some new and exciting fundraisers so please keep your eye on our FaceBook page and newsletter.
