Dear Parents/Caregivers

Beeliar Primary School's In-Term Swimming Program begins on Monday 6 February 2017 and runs until Friday 10 February 2017 for all children from Year 2 to Year 6.

The program is a part of the curriculum we offer in Western Australian (WA) public schools and children are expected to participate in these lessons. We appreciate that the cost is high but the lessons will provide your child/ren with very necessary life skills for living in WA.

The cost of swimming lessons is **\$25.00**. This is a reduced price as the children will only be swimming for one week with their session being an hour long instead of half hour sessions. This includes entry into South Lake Leisure Centre and bus fares to and from the venue. **Should you wish to watch your child swim, we must remind all parents that photography is not allowed at South Lake Leisure Centre.**

In the event that your child withdraws from the lessons, a refund will only be given for the pool entry portion of the costs. Refunds will be transferred into your child's unallocated credit account for future use. Single day absences cannot be refunded. If you have any concerns about paying the above costs, please contact the Manager Corporate Services, Mrs Cathy Fox on 9437 5955.

A number of students have unallocated credit from previous years, please contact the office if you would like to use some of this unallocated credit towards payment of the swimming lessons.

Payment for lessons should be made through the front office by close of business **Friday 9 December 2017**. Please make sure that the money and enrolment form are sent to school in the payment envelope provided with your child's name clearly labeled on it. Payment can also be made by EFTpos at the front office.

Contact the school as soon as possible if you have misplaced the enrolment form and we will issue you with a copy.

The swimming timetable will be published closer to the event once numbers have been confirmed.

The children are looking forward to their swimming experience and I thank you in anticipation of your support of this most worthwhile program.
