## Beeliar Primary School USE OF MOBILE PHONES AT SCHOOL POLICY

Mobile phones are an expensive item that the school cannot be responsible for and if used inappropriately are an unnecessary distraction to student learning and school operations. Mobile phones can be misused by students in the school setting and as a result they are not permitted to be brought to school.

The only exception to this is where parents provide written consent for their child to bring a phone to school for the following reasons:

**The child catches a bus to and from school.**

**The child has childcare or after school arrangements that requires them to be in communication with their parents.**

**For specific reasons as discussed and agreed to between the parents and school administration.**

If a parent wishes their child to have permission to have a mobile phone at school, they need to complete a form available from the school administration.

Where a student does have permission to have a mobile it is only to be used for the purpose agreed to by the school and parents. A student who uses the mobile phone in an inappropriate way will have the phone temporarily removed from them and repeated misuse may see their permission privileges cancelled.

The school takes no responsibility for theft or damage to mobile phones. If parents request the school can make arrangements for the mobile phone to be deposited and picked up from the school administration or class teacher before and after school.
