TODDLER TALES - STORY TELLING SESSIONS

Foundations of reading start well before children commence school. From birth, involve your child in singing, talking, lullabies, poetry, rhyming stories, story reading generally. Make it joyful, be expressive and enthusiastic and encourage communication by using eye contact, physical touch and speaking and listening skills. Hearing the sounds of voices, the words, the rhythm of language, helps develop the oral language system within the child's brain from birth and onwards.
