Under the School Education Act 1999, there is a requirement for schools to outline to parent(s)/carer(s), all Contributions and Charges that will apply to the education of their child/ren in the year ahead. Parent and staff representatives of the School Board, in consultation with parent groups and other staff members, have met to set a schedule, broken into four sections, of Contributions and Charges for 2022.

Voluntary Contributions (Section 99)

Contributions are non-compulsory and historically schools have always requested a contribution from parents to support the learning programmes that operate in the school. They are used to supplement the resources received by the school through government grants to provide the non-optional components of your child's education. In 2021 the School Board set the following voluntary contributions for 2022:

Kindergarten to Year 6 - \$60.00

The Beeliar Primary School 'voluntary contribution' will be used toward supporting programmes in a number of areas. These areas are outlined below with the part of the contribution that will be allocated also identified:-

- Numeracy Resources – extra materials for mathematics;
- Literacy Resources – extra reading and library books;
- Physical Education Resources – additional materials for physical programs including at break times;
- Extra materials for art and crafts, design and technology, including cooking ingredients and science activities;

Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components (Section 100)

These amounts vary from year level to year level and are the maximum that will be charged for students to attend activities. It is possible that actual charges will be less than that indicated. Charges are for optional parts of the curriculum that relate to specific learning activities but which depend on a payment being made. These include visiting performers, excursions, classroom activities etc. The charge might also apply to individual or small groups of students such as School of Instrumental Music program, School Choir or Interschool Sports competitors and Year 6 Camp.

This also covers other school activities provided through the school that are generally of a non-curriculum nature. These vary from student to student and charges will be advised at the time of the activity/event. They include Year 6 Graduation Shirts, Year 6 Graduation Dinner, Big Day Out, School Uniform, and School Photographs.

The school offers three payment options for Charges –

- Payment "Up-front" via the 2022 Students Requirement Items List sent home in Term 4 2021.
- Payment via EFTPOS, cash or online payment prior to Week 4, Term 1 2022.
- Payment "As it happens" - payment for each individual excursion, visit, activity at the time it is to occur.

The school promotes the a) & b) payment options for the following reasons. It ensures - the correct money is paid at the time of the activity, money is paid by the due date, prevents money being lost, misplaced or stolen, is one less job for busy parents to have or find and forward the correct money, reduces the administration and teaching time the teachers and office staff have to spend in collecting money for each activity separately.

Items for Students Use in the Educational Program

The cost for these items will vary from student to student. They include student's stationery items:

- For all students i.e. Items purchased through Ziggies Educational Supplies (the school's nominated seller) whose service is optional.
- Recommended but not essential e.g. Art Shirts, tissues, iPad

Fundraising Costs

During the year, the P & C and/or individual classes organise fund raising projects such as discos, fun days and social events to support the priorities in the school's plan or charities that the school identifies it would like to support during the year.

Details are overleaf explaining the costs for each section above.
