Cash should be placed in payment envelopes detailing student details and deposited in the drop boxes located in the front office.

Alternatively, parents are welcome to set up a regular direct deposit of a manageable amount, which can be held in credit on their child's account. Money held can be used to pay for events throughout the year such as camps, excursions and swimming lessons, easing the pressure to pay when they are due. Funds will only be allocated to events that you consent to and refunds are available if excess money remains at the end of the school year however, with your approval, these funds can also be rolled into the new year.
