Our Community

Beeliar Primary School proudly stands on Whadjuk boodja.

Beeliar Primary School is an Independent Public School located in the suburb of Beeliar within the City of Cockburn. Beeliar is a Noongar word that translates to 'river' or 'water running through'. The suburb of Beeliar includes a chain of lakes and wetlands that run parallel to the coast of WA, which is the origin of the name. Its traditional owners are the Beeliar Noongar people. Beeliar Noongar means 'river people,' and they are one of the clans of the Whadjuk, the Aboriginal people of the Perth metropolitan area.

Beeliar Primary School offers primary education from Kindergarten to Year Six. We share the site with the Fremantle Language Development Centre. A partnership is fostered between the two schools for sharing of expertise of teaching practice and connection with the community.

We value the connection to our community and work in partnership, with all members, to provide a high quality educational facility for all our students.



RECONCILIATION VISION

Beeliar Primary School is committed to contributing actively to reconciliation between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and non-Indigenous people. We aspire for students to be lifelong advocates of reconciliation through teaching and modelling respect and empathy. Beeliar Primary School will acknowledge and respect the significance of the local Beeliar Boodjar to Noongar people - past, present and emerging. The Beeliar Primary School community will be provided opportunities to develop their understanding of the importance of reconciliation to all Australians and prepare students to become advocates for, and participants in, reconciliation. At Beeliar, we are committed to truth-telling and being active participants in recognising and sharing the true histories of Australia and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples' perspectives within our classrooms.
